

Co-op Connections Card

East-Central Iowa Rural Electric Cooperative

Purpose

The purpose of East-Central Iowa REC offering a Co-op Connections card is two fold:

- 1. Encourage our members to shop locally rather than travel into Cedar Rapids or Walerloo/Cedar Falls.
- 2. Demonstrate another benefit of receiving electric power from a locally owned and controlled cooperative that maximizes customer satisfaction, not profits.

Merchant Responsibility

- 1. Sign a one year contract with East-Central to offer meaningful discounts to its members sufficient to draw people to your store. The merchant decides the terms of the discount.
- 2. Display window and cash register stickers at your establishment to indicate that you are a participant in the Co-op Connections Card program.
- 3. Train your employees and honor the card whenever it is presented to you.

Other than the discount there is no cost to participation.

East-Central Responsibility

- 1. Recruit local merchants to participate in the program.
- 2. Purchase the Co-op Connections cards from our national organization and distribute them to our 6,800 members.
- 3. Market the program regularly through East-Central's bi-monthly magazine, monthly bill stuffers, occasional newspaper ads, and our website, <u>www.ecirec.coop</u> (currently being redesigned). All local participants and their discounts will be listed in a special section of the website.
